Later they were called by God to Monterrey, Mexico on the North part of Mexico, and that was where Samuel grew up. His Family moved to Northeast Mexico to the City of Reynosa Tamaulipas, Mexico, and later on moved to San Antonio, Texas in 1975. From San Antonio, Texas they moved back to Mexico to start the Friends Church in Nueva Rosita Coahuila Mexico. In 1996-1977 (School year), was when the Friends Church officially started in Nueva Rosita Coahuila Mexico. They have been involved in the Lord's work always, and Samuel served alongside his parents doing Music Ministry and helping start missions and everything they could to help grow The Kingdom of God.
